We have strengthened partnerships with leading cardiovascular societies globally and in the Chinese Mainland, including the American College of Cardiology (ACC), Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society, Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology, British Cardio-Oncology Society, Chinese Cardiovascular Association, European Society of Cardiology, Guangdong Medical Association, Japanese Association of Cardiac Rehabilitation, Korean Society of Cardiology, Singapore Heart Foundation, and the Society for Cardiovascular Magnetic Resonance. Our Annual Scientific Congress (ASC) has firmly established itself as the flagship educational event for cardiovascular professionals in Hong Kong. The 34th ASC featured a comprehensive and high-quality scientific programme, including joint sessions with many esteemed international cardiac societies. It attracted enthusiastic participation from Hong Kong, the Chinese Mainland, and overseas, further underscoring our strong global connections. In addition to the main scientific sessions and workshops, we also successfully held the Eleventh Congregation of the College. Looking ahead, I am pleased to announce that the 35th ASC will be held in conjunction with ACC Asia in 2027. We look forward to yet another successful and impactful congress.

The 11th Asian Preventive Cardiology & Cardiac Rehabilitation Conference (APCCRC), scheduled for late 2026, will feature a one-day workshop within a three-day programme. This meeting will also mark the 20th Anniversary of APCCRC, under the theme “Sustainable Cardiovascular Health: Personalized Integration of Lifestyle, Technological and Environmental Interventions”.

We have continued to expand our scientific meetings and subspecialty Chapters to meet growing demands and remain at the forefront of cardiology advancements. The 7th Hong Kong Complex Cardiovascular Intervention (HKCCI), organized by the Cardiovascular Intervention Chapter, attracted nearly 300 faculty members and participants from 22 countries and regions. Meanwhile, as it approaches its 18th Anniversary, the Paediatric Cardiology Chapter continues to advance knowledge and practice in paediatric cardiology, benefiting both specialists and trainees. Our commitment to nurturing the next generation of cardiologists remains steadfast. This is reflected in the continued success of programmes such as the Hong Kong Core

Cardiology Certificate Course and the Intervention Fellow Course, both of which have been very well received.

Promoting heart health within the community remains a core mission of the College. Our World Heart Day Carnival cum Run for Heart 2025–26 attracted over 1,000 participants, while the Jump Rope for Heart Program continues to encourage healthy lifestyles and promote heart health among students. Report Summary



Since its establishment in 1992, the Hong Kong College of Cardiology (the College) has been continuing its mission to advance cardiovascular medicine and promote public health through scientific, professional, and educational activities, as well as international collaboration. Its ultimate goal is to promote the heart health of Hong Kong and uphold the highest standards of competence and ethical integrity in cardiovascular practice.

Co-organized by the Cardiovascular MRI & CT Chapter and Echocardiography Chapter of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology, the inaugural Hong Kong Heart Imaging Summit 2026 (HKHIS) was successfully took place on Sunday, 8 March 2026, at Cordis Hong Kong. HKHIS attracted over 200 registrations and featured a comprehensive programme including plenary lectures, luncheon symposia, hands-on workshops (3D Echo, Strain Imaging, and the HOCM), and an engaging Interesting Case Competition. The Summit received overwhelmingly positive feedback, marking a promising start for this new platform of knowledge exchange.

Another highlight of the year was the 34th Annual Scientific Congress of the College together with 11th Congregation was held from 5-7 June 2026, drawing over 980 registrations. Many renowned international experts in cardiovascular medicine contributed to this highly educational program. Strong international collaboration was one of the hallmarks, as exemplified by joint sessions with the American College of Cardiology, Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology, British Cardio-Oncology Society, European Society of Cardiology, Korean Society of Cardiology and the Society for Cardiovascular Magnetic Resonance.

Celebrating the 20th Anniversary, the 11th Asian Preventive Cardiology and Cardiac Rehabilitation Conference (APCCRC) will be held from 30 October to 1 November 2026 under the theme of “Sustainable Cardiovascular Health: Personalized Integration of Lifestyle, Technological and Environmental Interventions”. This biennial meeting will provide an excellent opportunity for sharing expertise on a wide range of topics in preventive cardiology and cardiac rehabilitation, attracting both local and international doctors and allied health professionals. The College also continued to co-organize the Hong Kong Core Cardiology Certificate Course with the Hong Kong Public Hospital Cardiologists Association, and the final Module 9 of the Second Cycle was successfully completed on 1 February 2026.

To further its core missions, the Scientific Committee and Public Health Education Committee continued to promote professional and public health education on heart diseases. Both committees were supported by

many enthusiastic young College fellows. Throughout the year, the College and its various chapters also organized a range of well-received local scientific programs.

The College has remained active in organizing community initiatives to promote cardiovascular health. The Jump Rope for Heart Program actively engaged schoolchildren in heart health promotion through rope skipping. Other notable event included the World Heart Day Carnival cum Run for Heart 2025-26, held on 11 January 2026 at Wu Kai Sha Youth Village, which served as a major annual highlight in public heart health advocacy.

In terms of professional development, the College supported cardiology trainees and fellows in pursuing advanced training at world-renowned overseas centres through the Hong Kong Heart Foundation Cardiology Training Fellowship Programme and Dr. C O PUN and Dr. Mary B L KWONG Scholarship.

The diverse and impactful activities would not be possible without the dedication and active participation of our members, the generous support of friends and sponsors, and the invaluable contributions of leading practitioners and academics both locally and internationally. The Council extends its heartfelt gratitude to all who have supported the College's mission.

Looking forward, the College remains committed to advancing cardiovascular care with clarity, innovation, and determination, continuing to make meaningful contributions to the health and well-being of the community.

Background

One of the most important missions of Hong Kong College of Cardiology (HKCC) is to promote the training and standard of our cardiology professionals so as to translate into better clinical patient care.

In view of the vast and tremendous explosions in knowledge with ever increasing new advances, it is becoming increasingly difficult for cardiologists and fellow trainees to stay abreast and keep up to date on core knowledge as well as new frontier technology.

However, the prerequisite of top-quality patient care depends highly on core clinical knowledge and experience. Therefore, HKCC determines to launch this first-of-its-kind certificate training course in 2018 and starts the 2nd cycle in 2023. We are pleased to have Hong Kong Public Hospital Cardiologists Association (HKPHCA), which shares similar aims, to co-organize the course.

Goal

The goal of the course is for our cardiology professionals to enhance their core cardiology knowledge and skill in day-to-day clinical practice.

Course Description

The Course consists of 9 modules, each of one-day duration, over the period of 3 years. It provides a comprehensive broad base and up-to-date review of clinical diseases and the management. Topics included general cardiology, coronary artery disease, arrhythmia, valvular & pericardial disease, heart failure & cardiomyopathy, congenital heart disease, hypertension, perioperative consult, clinical electrophysiology, core echocardiographic & interventional knowhow & tips, critical cardiac care, and pearls of wisdom from the experts. Approach to common symptoms, intelligent use of investigations and tips & tricks in intervention &

device usage will be highlighted. The course also serves as good review for trainees to prepare for cardiology examinations.

Target Participants

All cardiologists in clinical practice and fellow trainees will benefit from the course. Due to limited capacity and to allow more interaction, fellows in training who are also members of HKCC / HKPHCA have priority for enrollment.

Certification

A short examination will be held at the end of each module. Delegates passing the examination will get a certificate of that module. Upon completion and passing examination of at least 6 out of 9 modules, delegate will get a certificate for the Course.

Progress

All modules were very well received with most delegates stayed through the whole day program and provided excellent feedback. Due to overwhelming responses for participation, the capacity for most modules had to be expanded to around 80 or more to accommodate for request from enthusiastic members.

The 9th module was successfully held drawing 76 cardiologists, anesthesiologist, surgeon, general practitioner and trainees to participate in the course. 36 attendees took the examination with 100% passing rate. 16 participants completed online evaluation forms and most of them strongly agreed the course achieved its stated objectives, organized clearly and logically and enhanced participants' learning. Overall, all the interviewees were very satisfied with the course with a high rating of 4.22 on a scale of 5.

34th Annual Scientific Congress of Hong Kong College of Cardiology 5-7 June 2026

The 34th Annual Scientific Congress of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology was successfully held from 5 to 7 June 2026 in Meeting Rooms S221–230, Level 2, at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre.

In addition to the theme-based symposia, the Allied Cardiovascular Health Professional Symposium and the Paediatric Cardiology Symposium were held on 6 June 2026. The Cardiology Course for Family Physicians and General Practitioners took place on 7 June 2026. The Hong Kong Heart Foundation Lecture, delivered by Dr. Katherine FAN and chaired by Dr. CHAN Kwok Keung, Dr. KO Tak Him, and Dr. LEUNG Tat Chi, Godwin, was held on the afternoon of 6 June 2026 immediately after the Congregation and Opening Ceremony. The Journal of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology Session was held on the morning of 7 June 2026. A round table discussion titled “A Multidisciplinary Dialogue for Optimizing Perioperative Care for the Frail Elderly” and an ECG workshop were also held on the afternoon of 7 June 2026.

This year, six joint sessions were organized in collaboration with the American College of Cardiology (ACC), the Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology (APSC), the British Cardio-Oncology Society (BCOS), the European Society of Cardiology (ESC), the Korean Society of Cardiology (KSC), and the Society for Cardiovascular Magnetic Resonance (SCMR).

Jump Rope for Heart Program (JRFH) (跳繩強心) 2025-2026

In this academic year (2025-2026), 50 schools (42 primary schools, 7 secondary schools, and 1 international school) have joined the Jump Rope for Heart Program. Over 1,270,000 students from 675 schools have joined the program over the past twenty-seven years.

The JRFH Speed Rope Skipping Competition 2026 was successfully held on 26 April 2026 (Sun) at S.K.H. St. Andrew's Primary School (聖公會聖安德烈小學). Each participant could join 1 to 5 events, with an entry fee of \$100 per event. Thirty-two primary schools and sixteen secondary schools participated in the competition this year.

The annual JRFH Inter-school Rope Skipping Competition was the highlight of the year, providing an opportunity for students to showcase their talents and exchange skills with others. Thirty primary schools and 18 secondary schools participated in the competition on 5 July 2026 at Christian Alliance International School (宣道國際學校). The Rotary Club CPR & AED Education Project 2025/2026 was jointly organized by HKCC, the Rotary Club of Hong Kong Northeast, and the St. John Ambulance Association for the 10th year. Dr. TSUI Kin Lam attended the opening ceremony on behalf of HKCC on 22 November 2025 at St. John Headquarters. Similar to the previous year, the JRFH secretariat assisted in recruiting 100 teachers to participate in a one-day CRP & AED certificate course at St. John Headquarters, free of charge. A total of 60 teachers attended the one-day CPR & AED certificate courses on 15 November 2025 and 15 March 2026.

The Joyful Fruit Month project was jointly organized by HKCC and the Department of Health. The project was renamed to Joyful Fruit & Veg Month from 2025/26. A maximum of HK\$2,000 per school is granted to a maximum of 75 schools per year. As of 22 June 2026, 58 schools have claimed HK\$101,448.36 for Joyful Fruit Month 2026.

The Hong Kong Delegation participated in the IJRU Championships 2025 in Kawasaki, Japan, from 27 July to 3 August 2025. The Hong Kong delegation won 39 gold, 42 silver, and 55 bronze medals (a total of 136 medals). HKCC donated HK\$480,000 to support 370 athletes and coaches. And the celebration dinner was held at the New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel on 29 August 2025 (Friday).

Special thanks to Mr. Tsang Wing Cho, who, on behalf of his late father, Mr. Tsang Fu Keung, has generously donated HK\$40,000 to support our program in this academic year.
